Sinai Health provides exemplary care for patients living with heart failure, 99% of whom are not eligible for heart transplants.

Our physicians developed the first vital risk score now used worldwide



This score helps predict which women have the highest chance of cardiac complications during pregnancy, so patients and their physicians can make more informed decisions and plans.

The experts at Mount Sinai's Cardiac Catheterization Lab diagnose some of the most complicated patient conditions and recommend optimal treatments. Each year, our lab acts as a true research powerhouse, enabling our clinician researchers to study large patient populations, advancing global understanding of what a healthy cardiovascular system looks like and the factors that cause it to fail, paving the way for more effective treatments for patients today and in the future.

Dr. Susanna Mak has developed the renowned BREATH program to provide state-of-the-art diagnostics for breathlessness related to aging and heart failure. She and her team are using this platform to research the causes of "long covid" (COVID-19 Long Syndrome).
